#KurthCares Safety Guidelines 2020-2021

Arrival

- Our school day is from 7:40 a.m. to 3:05 p.m. Our staff will be on duty to get your children to the correct location beginning at 7:15 a.m. Students who arrive by car will need to be dropped off in the front circle drive between 7:15 and 7:40 a.m. Please do not drop off your child at any other entrance or on the road. Our back York Dr. circle is for PACK and bus drop off students only.
- Please do not park in the Teacher Only parking which is located on York Drive.
- Do not let your child out of the car until adults are on the sidewalk.
- Both car and bus riders will use hand sanitizer immediately upon entering the building.
- In order to keep our students and staff safe, parents will not be allowed to walk students to classrooms (including on the first day of school).
- Students will be socially distanced in different areas by grade level until teachers arrive at 7:30 a.m.
- All students will be offered a grab and go breakfast between 7:15 and 7:40 a.m. Breakfast and lunch are free for all students.

Dismissal

- Please make sure that your child is **picked up daily by 3:05 p.m**. We need all parents to display their parent tags on their rear-view mirror. If you need additional tags, please let us know. We will not allow anyone to pick up children without a car tag.
- All students must be picked up in the front car circle. If you walk up, you will need to wait in the designated area until your child is brought to you.
- All students will remain in their classrooms and be dismissed individually to maintain social distancing during
 this busy time of day. You will pick up your child beside a designated number sign. Only one lane will be used
 for pick up.

We do not check students out or take transportation changes after 2:30 p.m.

• Please do not use your cell phone or play loud music while driving in the circle or anywhere in the Kurth school zone. Any cell phone use is against the law in a school zone.

Campus Visitors

- Visitors will be limited throughout the day. Parent conferences will be held virtually or through phone calls.
 In case of an emergency or if a prior appointment has been approved. All visitors must answer a COVID
 questionnaire and will not allowed to enter the building if they have received a positive diagnosis, have been
 around someone who has COVID, or is experiencing any COVID symptoms. Each visitor will be asked to scan a
 QR code from their phone to answer the questionnaire before entering the building.
- Social distancing guidelines will be followed and all visitors must wear a mask.
- No outside visitors or parents will be allowed to come to school for lunch until further notice.
- Outside food deliveries will not be allowed until further notice.
- If you need to sign your child in or out, please follow social distancing guidelines in the foyer.
